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### All Phases Now Open in Missouri

With the stroke of midnight this (Friday) morning, all three vaccination phases in the state of Missouri are now eligible to receive the vaccine. The Audrain County Health Department (ACHD) is following Governor Mike Parson's order to make the vaccine available to all that request it in any of the three phases put in place for vaccine distribution by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services.

Starting today (Friday), any Audrain County resident requesting a Moderna vaccine at the health department can request an appointment at [www.myachd.as.me](http://www.myachd.as.me) or call 573-591-3755 to schedule an appointment. Residents have to be aged 18 or older to receive the Moderna vaccine. Or, residents can sign up for two upcoming clinics in Audrain County to receive the Moderna vaccine, one in Vandalia at the Eastern Missouri Family YMCA on Thursday and one in Mexico at the ACHD next Friday. To sign up for either of these clinics, put on by the ACHD and the Missouri National Guard, residents need to secure an appointment through Missouri's COVID Navigator web site.
